

Instructions for Authors

1. Submission Policy

All manuscripts must be prepared using **LaTeX**. Authors should submit their papers through the journal's online submission system:

<https://www.aiaseducation.org/journal-index.php>

All submissions are subject to **peer review**. Based on referee reports, authors may be required to revise their manuscripts. The Editorial Board reserves the right to make minor editorial changes to improve clarity and consistency.

Submission of a manuscript implies that:

- The work is **original**;
- It has **not been published previously**;
- It is **not under consideration elsewhere**.

Submitted manuscripts will **not be returned**.

2. Manuscript Preparation

General Format

- Manuscripts must be written in English.
- All content must be typeset using LaTeX.
- Page Size & Margins: A4 size with 1.25" (3.17 cm) left/right margins and 1" (2.54 cm) top/bottom margins.
- Header (Subsequent Pages):
 - Even Pages: Author Name(s) (Centered, 10pt Small Caps).
 - Odd Pages: Running title, maximum 45 characters including spaces (Centered, 10pt Italic).
- Typography:

- Body Text: 11pt Computer Modern or Times New Roman, single-spaced, justified.
- Paper Title: 16pt, Bold, Centered.
- Section Headings: 12pt, Bold, Left-aligned or Centered.

First Page Requirements

The first page of the manuscript must include:

- Title of the paper
- Author name(s) and affiliation(s), Include full postal address and email address
- Abstract (Length: 50–200 words)
- Keywords (Provide 3–5 keywords)
- Mathematics Subject Classification (MSC 2010)
- Running title (Maximum 45 characters, including spaces)

The corresponding author's full contact details should be provided separately.

3. Text and Style Guidelines

Structure

- Use clearly defined section headings and subheadings.
- Ensure logical organization and mathematical rigor throughout.

Notation and Units

- Use standard mathematical notation.
- Units, symbols, and abbreviations should conform to the **International System of Units (SI)**.

Equations

- Equations must be clearly typeset using LaTeX.
- Number equations consecutively using **Arabic numerals in parentheses**, aligned to the right margin:
Example:
($E = mc^2$) (1)

- All symbols should be properly defined when first introduced.

4. References

Citation in Text

- References should be cited using **Arabic numerals in square brackets** (e.g., [1], [2]).
- Citations should follow a consistent ordering system.

Reference List

References must be listed at the end of the manuscript. Entries should be formatted consistently and include complete bibliographic details.

- **Journal Articles**
 - Format:
[Number] Author(s): Title. *Journal Name* **Volume**, page range (Year).
 - Example:
[1] Tao, T.: The Gaussian primes contain arbitrarily shaped constellations. *J. Anal. Math.* **99**, 109–176 (2006).
- **Books**
 - Format:
[Number] Author(s): *Title*. Publisher, Place of publication (Year).
 - Example:
[1] Aleksandrov, A. D., Kolmogorov, A. N., Lavrent'ev, M. A.: *Mathematics: Its Content, Methods and Meaning (3 Volumes in One)*. Dover Publications, New York (1999).

5. After Acceptance

Upon acceptance, authors must:

- Submit the final PDF version of the manuscript;
- Provide all source LaTeX files if requested;
- Sign a Copyright Transfer Agreement, assigning copyright to the publisher.

6. Editorial Policy

The Editorial Board reserves the right to make editorial corrections to improve readability and consistency , and ensure compliance with journal standards and formatting requirements. Authors must adhere to standard academic publishing ethics, including proper citation of sources , avoidance of plagiarism , and accurate representation of results.

7. Ethical Standards

Authors must adhere to standard academic publishing ethics, including:

- Proper citation of sources;
- Avoidance of plagiarism;
- Accurate representation of results.
